More than 25,000 families per year travel to Tulsa for inpatient medical care, many without financial resources for lodging and food during a lengthy medical stay. The Hospitality House of Tulsa serves as a “home away from home” for these families, who would otherwise be forced to sleep in waiting rooms or vehicles and eat out of vending machines. Rather than confining our hospitality to the organization’s limited space , our volunteers come together on *A Night of Hospitality* to serve these families by assembling and hand-delivering 500 “waiting room survival kits” to hospital waiting rooms for families in need.

Items Needed for Waiting Room Survival Kits:

- Lap blankets
- Neck roll pillows (ask for pattern)
- Bottled water
- Microwavable Soup (Soup at Hand or Healthy Choice)
- Crackers
- Breakfast bars
- Hand sanitizer
- Travel size tissue
- Wet wipes
- Travel size hygiene items (shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant)
- Toothbrushes & toothpaste
- Encouraging reading material
- Coloring books & crayons
