

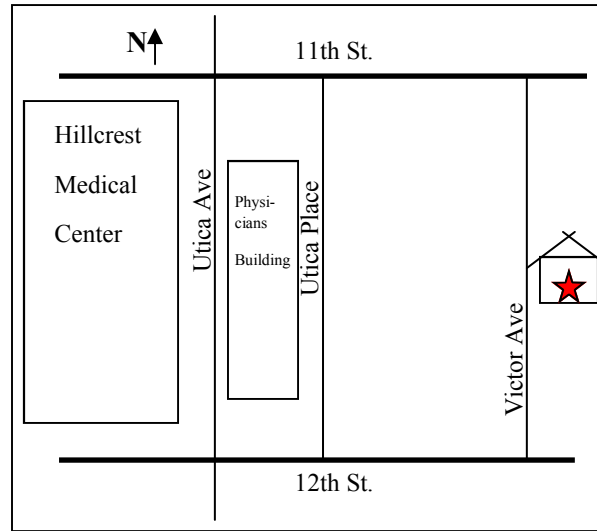

# Common Questions:

## **Q: Who can stay at The Hospitality House?**

**A:** Family members of inpatients being treated at any Tulsa Hospital who live more than 30 miles outside the greater Tulsa area.

## **Q: Do guests need a reservation?**

**A:** To stay at The Hospitality House, guests must be referred by a social worker, case manager, nurse, chaplain, or physician.

## **Q: Is there a charge to the families?**

**A:** Because we are a non-profit organization, we ask our families to contribute a nominal donation to help defray costs. Suggested donations range from \$1—\$10 a night to help defray the costs of upkeep and operations.
